1. \_\_\_ On that day did the king \_\_\_\_\_ give the \_\_\_\_\_ of Haman the Jews' enemy unto Esther the \_\_\_\_\_. And Mordecai came before the king; for \_\_\_\_\_ had told what he [was] unto her.
