1. \_\_\_ Twenty and \_\_\_\_\_ years old was he when he began to reign; and he reigned \_\_\_\_\_ and nine years in Jerusalem. His mother's name also [was] \_\_\_\_\_, the daughter of \_\_\_\_\_.
