

## II Samuel 14:1-33

Date \_\_\_\_\_

1. \_\_\_ And Joab sent to \_\_\_\_\_, and fetched thence a wise \_\_\_\_\_, and said unto her, I pray thee, \_\_\_\_\_ thyself to be a \_\_\_\_\_, and put on now mourning \_\_\_\_\_, and anoint not thyself with \_\_\_\_\_, but be as a woman that had a long time \_\_\_\_\_ for the dead:
2. \_\_\_ And thy \_\_\_\_\_ had two sons, and they two \_\_\_\_\_ together in the field, and [there was] none to \_\_\_\_\_ them, but the one smote the other, and \_\_\_\_\_ him.
3. \_\_\_ And the \_\_\_\_\_ said, \_\_\_\_\_ saith [ought] unto thee, \_\_\_\_\_ him to me, and he shall not \_\_\_\_\_ thee any more.
4. \_\_\_ Then said she, I \_\_\_\_\_ thee, let the king \_\_\_\_\_ the LORD thy God, that thou wouldest not suffer the revengers of \_\_\_\_\_ to \_\_\_\_\_ any more, lest they destroy my son. And he said, [As] the LORD liveth, there shall not one \_\_\_\_\_ of thy son fall to the \_\_\_\_\_.
5. \_\_\_ For the king will \_\_\_\_\_, to deliver his \_\_\_\_\_ out of the hand of the man [that would] destroy me and my \_\_\_\_\_ together out of the \_\_\_\_\_ of God.
6. \_\_\_ Then thine \_\_\_\_\_ said, The word of my lord the \_\_\_\_\_ shall now be \_\_\_\_\_: for as an \_\_\_\_\_ of God, so [is] my \_\_\_\_\_ the king to discern \_\_\_\_\_ and bad: therefore the LORD thy God will be with thee.
7. \_\_\_ And the king said unto \_\_\_\_\_, Behold now, I have done this thing: \_\_\_\_\_ therefore, bring the \_\_\_\_\_ man \_\_\_\_\_ again.
8. \_\_\_ But in all Israel there was none to be so much \_\_\_\_\_ as Absalom for his \_\_\_\_\_: from the sole of his \_\_\_\_\_ even to the \_\_\_\_\_ of his head there was no \_\_\_\_\_ in him.
9. \_\_\_ And when he \_\_\_\_\_ his head, (for it was at \_\_\_\_\_ year's end that he polled [it]: because [the hair] was \_\_\_\_\_ on him, therefore he polled it:) he weighed the \_\_\_\_\_ of his head at two hundred \_\_\_\_\_ after the king's weight.
10. \_\_\_ So Joab came to the \_\_\_\_\_, and told him: and when he had called for \_\_\_\_\_, he came to the king, and \_\_\_\_\_ himself on his \_\_\_\_\_ to the ground before the king: and the king \_\_\_\_\_ Absalom.
