

# I Samuel 5:1-12

Date \_\_\_\_\_

1. \_\_\_ When the \_\_\_\_\_ took the \_\_\_\_\_ of God, they brought it into the \_\_\_\_\_ of Dagon, and \_\_\_\_\_ it by Dagon.
2. \_\_\_ And when they of \_\_\_\_\_ arose early on the \_\_\_\_\_, behold, Dagon [was] fallen upon his \_\_\_\_\_ to the \_\_\_\_\_ before the \_\_\_\_\_ of the LORD. And they took Dagon, and set him in his \_\_\_\_\_ again.
3. \_\_\_ And when they arose \_\_\_\_\_ on the morrow \_\_\_\_\_, behold, Dagon [was] fallen upon his \_\_\_\_\_ to the ground before the \_\_\_\_\_ of the LORD; and the \_\_\_\_\_ of Dagon and both the \_\_\_\_\_ of his \_\_\_\_\_ [were] cut off upon the threshold; only [the stump of] Dagon was left to him.
4. \_\_\_ Therefore neither the \_\_\_\_\_ of Dagon, nor any that come into Dagon's \_\_\_\_\_, tread on the \_\_\_\_\_ of Dagon in \_\_\_\_\_ unto this day.
5. \_\_\_ But the \_\_\_\_\_ of the LORD was \_\_\_\_\_ upon them of Ashdod, and he \_\_\_\_\_ them, and smote them with emerods, [even] Ashdod and the \_\_\_\_\_ thereof.
6. \_\_\_ And when the men of \_\_\_\_\_ saw that [it was] so, they said, The \_\_\_\_\_ of the God of Israel shall not \_\_\_\_\_ with us: for his \_\_\_\_\_ is sore upon us, and upon Dagon our god.
7. \_\_\_ They sent therefore and gathered all the \_\_\_\_\_ of the \_\_\_\_\_ unto them, and said, What shall we do with the \_\_\_\_\_ of the God of Israel? And they answered, Let the \_\_\_\_\_ of the God of Israel be carried \_\_\_\_\_ unto Gath. And they carried the \_\_\_\_\_ of the God of Israel about [thither].
8. \_\_\_ Therefore they sent the \_\_\_\_\_ of God to \_\_\_\_\_. And it came to pass, as the ark of God came to Ekron, that the Ekronites \_\_\_\_\_ out, saying, They have \_\_\_\_\_ about the ark of the God of Israel to us, to \_\_\_\_\_ us and our people.
