

# Isaiah 53:1-12

1. \_\_\_ Who hath \_\_\_\_\_ our \_\_\_\_\_? and to whom is the \_\_\_\_\_ of the LORD revealed?
2. \_\_\_ For he shall grow up before him as a \_\_\_\_\_ plant, and as a \_\_\_\_\_ out of a dry ground: he hath no \_\_\_\_\_ nor \_\_\_\_\_; and when we shall see him, [there is] no \_\_\_\_\_ that we should desire him.
3. \_\_\_ He is despised and \_\_\_\_\_ of men; a \_\_\_\_\_ of sorrows, and \_\_\_\_\_ with grief: and we hid as it were [our] \_\_\_\_\_ from him; he was despised, and we \_\_\_\_\_ him not.
4. \_\_\_ But he [was] \_\_\_\_\_ for our transgressions, [he was] \_\_\_\_\_ for our iniquities: the chastisement of our \_\_\_\_\_ [was] upon him; and with his \_\_\_\_\_ we are \_\_\_\_\_.
5. \_\_\_ All we like \_\_\_\_\_ have gone \_\_\_\_\_; we have turned every one to his own \_\_\_\_\_; and the LORD hath \_\_\_\_\_ on him the iniquity of us all.
6. \_\_\_ He was \_\_\_\_\_, and he was afflicted, yet he opened not his \_\_\_\_\_: he is brought as a \_\_\_\_\_ to the slaughter, and as a \_\_\_\_\_ before her \_\_\_\_\_ is dumb, so he \_\_\_\_\_ not his \_\_\_\_\_.
7. \_\_\_ And he made his \_\_\_\_\_ with the wicked, and with the \_\_\_\_\_ in his death; because he had done no \_\_\_\_\_, neither [was any] \_\_\_\_\_ in his \_\_\_\_\_.
8. \_\_\_ Yet it pleased the LORD to \_\_\_\_\_ him; he hath put [him] to \_\_\_\_\_: when thou shalt make his soul an \_\_\_\_\_ for sin, he shall see [his] \_\_\_\_\_, he shall prolong [his] days, and the \_\_\_\_\_ of the LORD shall prosper in his hand.
