

## Titus 3:1-15

1. 1 Put them in mind to be subject to principalities and powers, to obey magistrates, to be ready to every good work,
2. 2 To speak evil of no man, to be no brawlers, [but] gentle, shewing all meekness unto all men.
3. 4 But after that the kindness and love of God our Saviour toward man appeared,
4. 5 Not by works of righteousness which we have done, but according to his mercy he saved us, by the washing of regeneration, and renewing of the Holy Ghost;
5. 7 That being justified by his grace, we should be made heirs according to the hope of eternal life.
6. 8 [This is] a faithful saying, and these things I will that thou affirm constantly, that they which have believed in God might be careful to maintain good works. These things are good and profitable unto men.
7. 9 But avoid foolish questions, and genealogies, and contentions, and strivings about the law; for they are unprofitable and vain.
8. 10 A man that is an heretick after the first and second admonition reject;
9. 14 And let ours also learn to maintain good works for necessary uses, that they be not unfruitful.
10. 15 All that are with me salute thee. Greet them that love us in the faith. Grace [be] with you all. Amen
