Titus 3:1-15

- 1. Put them in mind to be subject to principalities and powers, to obey magistrates, to be ready to every good work,
- 2. 2 To speak evil of no man, to be no brawlers, [but] gentle, shewing all meekness unto all men.
- 3. 4 But after that the kindness and love of God our Saviour toward man appeared,
- 4. 5 Not by works of righteousness which we have done, but according to his mercy he saved us, by the washing of regeneration, and renewing of the Holy Ghost;
- 5. 7 That being justified by his grace, we should be made heirs according to the hope of eternal life.
- 6. 8 [This is] a faithful saying, and these things I will that thou affirm constantly, that they which have believed in God might be careful to maintain good works. These things are good and profitable unto men.
- 7. 9 But avoid foolish questions, and genealogies, and contentions, and strivings about the law; for they are unprofitable and vain.
- 8. 10 A man that is an heretick after the first and second admonition reject;
- 9. 14 And let ours also learn to maintain good works for necessary uses, that they be not unfruitful.
- 10. 15 All that are with me salute thee. Greet them that love us in the faith. Grace [be] with you all. Amen
