Jeremiah 7:28 “But thou shalt say unto them, This is a nation that obeyeth not the voice of the LORD their God, nor receiveth correction: truth is perished, and is cut off from their mouth.

Hebrews 1:1, 2 “<sup>1</sup>God, who at sundry times and in divers manners spake in time past unto the fathers by the prophets, <sup>2</sup>Hath in these last days spoken unto us by his Son, whom he hath appointed heir of all things, by whom also he made the worlds;”

Somewhat related to the previous article, the truth that is cut off from the mouth of people are the words of Jesus. The writer of Hebrews lets us know that in times past and in different ways the LORD spoke unto the fathers by the prophets. We read and study and learn from these words the LORD gave to these prophets of old, but in these last days, we are to obey the words of Jesus.

I’ve written recently about the last days and the scriptures clearly show we are in the last days and last times. It’s the last days in that there is not another “era” coming. There was the partrichal age, Mosaic age, and now the Christian age. These are these last days. There is not another plan or age to come upon this Earth. We must obey the words of Jesus and the teachings of the New Testament if we are to go to Heaven.

The words of the prophets are still as true today as when they were spoken, but we are not under the old law and do not follow the ordinaces thereof. Paul wrote in Colossians 2:14, “*Blotting out the handwriting of ordinances that was against us, which was contrary to us, and took it out of the way, nailing it to his cross;*”

We learn from the old law. Romans 15:4 says, “*For whatsoever things were written aforetime were written for our learning, that we through patience and comfort of the scriptures might have hope.*” We learn from these words of old and obtain patience, comfort, and hope.

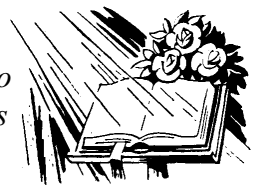
