"By Inspiration of God"

Paul wrote in II Timothy 3:16, "All scripture is given by inspiration of God, and is profitable for doctrine, for reproof, for correction, for instruction in righteousness:" The phrase in the first portion of the verse translated "given by inspiration of God" is from the single Greek word, (Theopneustos). This single Greek term is made up of two Greek words, (Theos), which means "God," and (pneuma), which means "spirit." The first part of this verse could have been justly translated, "All scripture is God's spirit."

Do you want to know about God and His will for us? What does the Lord have to say to us? Many claim to receive revelations and messages from God or angels, but this claim is contrary to the teachings of the Bible. Paul wrote in Galatians 1:8, "But though we, or an angel from heaven, preach any other gospel unto you than that which we have preached unto you, let him be accursed."
