The Bible has much to say about the heart. The word "heart" is found in 765 verses of the King James Version and 796 verses of the American Standard Version. The Bible rarely refers to the physical heart. An exception is when Absalom was thrust through the heart with darts in II Samuel 18:14.

The heart the Bible discusses is the spirit of people—their most inner being. It is who they are. Here are some passages from the Bible regarding the heart:

Proverbs 23:6, "For as he thinketh in his heart, so [is] he. . ."

Jeremiah 11:20, "But, O LORD of hosts, that judgest righteously, that triest the reins and the heart. . ."

Luke 10:27, "Thou shalt love the Lord thy God with all thy heart."


