No Warning

his past Friday a meteor streaked across the sky in Russia leaving a glowing trail. The meteor exploded causing a blindingly bright light that even rivaled the sun for a moment.



The shock waves sent from the exploding meteor broke glass in thousands of buildings, knocked down walls, and

injured well over 1,000 people. The sound from the explosion was extremely loud. It was the sound which caused, by far, most of the damage from the meteor.

You can view actual footage of the meteor streaking across the sky, igniting as it entered the atmosphere, and then blazing with intense light at the end of it's journey.

This meteor had no doubt been in space since the beginning of creation. On that crisp, clear winter's day, it's path crossed with the Earth. There was no warning whatsoever. It just happened in a moment. Suddenly, there it was. People were saying there was no

warning. There is no way for there to be any warning of such an event.

To those who say there was no warning, I would say, the event itself can serve as a warning. There will be another event to unfold in the sky. Only a hand full of people saw the meteor, but, this other event, every eye shall see.

The LORD shall appear with all His holy angels and the sound of the trumpet. All living and dead alike shall see him. I Corinthians 15:52 tells us regarding this event, "In a moment, in the twinkling of an eye, at the last trump: for the trumpet shall sound, and the dead shall be raised incorruptible, and we shall be changed."

I Thessalonians 4:15-17 tells even more. There will be three sounds and we will meet the LORD in the clouds to ever be with Him. "15For this we say unto you by the word of the Lord, that we which are alive [and] remain unto the coming of the Lord shall not prevent them which are asleep. ¹⁶For the Lord himself shall descend from heaven with a shout, with the voice of the archangel, and with the trump of God: and the dead in Christ shall rise first: 17Then we which are alive [and] remain shall be caught up together with them in the clouds, to meet the Lord in the air: and so shall we ever be with the Lord."

A meteor of the magnitude of the one last Friday might never hit the Earth again, but it's guaranteed that the LORD will return. There will be no signs or indications. Only God the Father knows the time.

For those not in the LORD, it will be the most horrible time imaginable. They will cry for the mountains and rocks to fall upon them. (Revelation 6:16) For those in the LORD, it will be the most blessed day imaginable. We are to look toward and hasten that day. Peter wrote in II Peter 3:12, "Looking for and hasting unto the coming of the day of God, wherein the heavens being on fire shall be dissolved, and the elements shall melt with fervent heat?"

Let the meteor of last Friday, which had no warning, serve as our warning. An event will with certainty unfold in the sky. That event will be to our everlasting destruction or our eternal life.

Outside of the United States, the most listeners we receive are from Europe and India. Many are beginning to listen from Africa and southeast Asia. Just as I was heading to bed Friday night I noted there were listeners from Singapore and Brazil. We are also getting a very high number of listeners from Arabian countries.

These just happen to be the ones I see. I can check the logs and see where every listener is from, but there are so many I tend to just do random checks.

There are many people in the world wanting to learn the truth and know about the Gospel. I read this past week there are an estimated six billion cell phones in the world. With the widespread use of cell phones connected to the Internet, the Gospel is going into places previously unreachable. With the recording and archiving of our
