No Warning

hree years ago in February, 2013, year a meteor streaked across the sky in Russia leaving a glowing trail. The meteor exploded causing a blindingly bright light that even rivaled the sun for a moment.

The shock waves sent from the exploding meteor broke glass in thousands of buildings, knocked down walls, and injured well over 1,000 people. The sound

from the explosion was extremely loud. It was the sound which caused most of the damage from the meteor.

You can view actual footage of the meteor streaking across the sky, igniting as it entered the atmosphere, and then blazing with intense light at the end of it's journey. (Search for 2013 Russian meteor on YouTube)

This meteor had no doubt been in space since the beginning of creation. On that crisp, clear winter's day, it's path crossed with the Earth. There was no warning whatsoever. It just happened in a

moment. Suddenly, there it was. People were saying there was no warning. There is no way for there to be any warning of such an event.

To those who say there was no warning, I would say, the event itself can serve as a warning. There will be another event to unfold in the sky. Only a hand full of people saw the meteor, but, this other event, every eye shall see.

The LORD shall appear with all His holy angels and the sound of the trumpet. All living and dead alike shall see him. I Corinthians 15:52 tells us regarding this event, "*In a moment, in the twinkling of an eye, at the last trump: for the trumpet shall sound, and the dead shall be raised incorruptible, and we shall be changed.*"

I Thessalonians 4:15-17 tells even more. There will be three sounds and we will meet the LORD in the clouds to ever be with Him. Let the meteor of last year, which had no warning, serve as our warning. An event will with certainty unfold in the sky. That event will be to our everlasting destruction or our eternal life.
