

came online in 1995, and we were one of the very first congregations of the Church to have a website. The best I could determine at the time there were only twelve other congregations online when we went online.)

We have had thousands of visitors over the past four years from all over the U. S. and many other countries. You can see on the world map when you log on where people are located that have been connecting. Dozens log in every day to hear the Bible being read.
