## 1000 Miles

A few years ago we traveled to Calico Rock, Arkansas to a family reunion. Before we backed out of the driveway, we reset the trip odometer to zero to measure the total driving distance of the trip.

During the course of our visit, there were numerous unplanned excursions—trips to a store, a visit in the area of Ruby's mother's home place, a drive down a side road that was decided upon at the last moment, a slightly different route home than originally planned, etc. These examples are but a few of the many excursions made.

As we neared home, I noted that the trip odometer indicated we had driven 999.7 miles. I remarked that it looked as though our trip was going to be about 1000 miles. At the exact moment I arrived at the driveway, the odometer indicated we had driven 1000.0 miles—not 999.9 nor 1000.1, but exactly 1000 miles to the tenth.

Could we have planned this so precisely? Probably not. It was just a happenstance. I doubt we could do it again. As I look back, every little extra drive taken, every decision to not take a road, etc., all played an integral part in the trip being exactly 1000 miles. Any one trip omitted or extra one taken would have caused

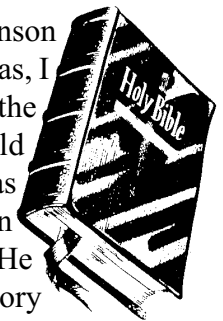
