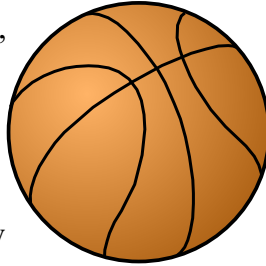

—make the introduction, that may not be necessary, but that will demonstrate friendliness.

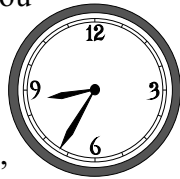
—write a note to a person who is ill, or who has lost a member of the family.
