John 11:20, "Then Martha, as soon as she heard that Jesus was coming, went and met him: but Mary sat [still] in the house."

In John 11 we have the account of where Jesus is returning to the place where Lazarus had died. Word came to Martha that Jesus was coming. When she heard this, she went out to meet Him.

When Jesus returns, it will be in the clouds. Revelation 1:7, "Behold, he cometh with clouds; and every eye shall see him, and they [also] which pierced him: and all kindreds of the earth shall wail because of him. Even so, Amen."
