what they do? [even] the great abominations that the house of Israel committeth here, that I should go far off from my sanctuary? but turn thee yet again, [and] thou shalt see greater abominations.”

They had done such abominable things in the house of God that He could no longer stay there. They had made images of their idols upon the walls. Ezekiel was taken to the gate of the LORD’s house (Ezekiel 8:14) and women were weeping for the false god Tammuz.

In verse 16 we are told, *“And he brought me into the inner court of the LORD’S house, and, behold, at the door of the temple of the LORD, between the porch and the altar, [were] about five and twenty men, with their backs toward the temple of the LORD, and their faces toward the east; and they worshipped the sun toward the east.”* They literally turned their backs upon the temple and were worshipping the sun. The LORD brought great destruction upon them because of these sins.

Just as Jesus visited the temple daily and taught, let’s make sure that Jesus visits our spiritual temples daily. Let Him come in and teach us from His word. Let’s live in such a way that we do not drive Him out by the hardness of our hearts and turning our backs to the temple like those Ezekiel saw. When we do, we too will drive the LORD from His temple and from our lives. —Marty Edwards❖
